<i>Amelanchier x grandiflora</i>	Serviceberry, Single trunk	Autumn Brilliance, Princess Diana	15-25	15-25	Oval to rounded; orange/red fall color; white flowers in April	Single trunk can develop suckers at base due to natural multi-stemmed habit
<i>Carpinus betulus</i>	Hornbeam, European		40-60	30-40	Rounded shape with dark green leaves; yellow fall color	a shade-loving tree, which prefers moderate soil fertility and moisture
<i>Celtis occidentalis</i>	Hackberry		40-60	40-60	Round-topped head and pendulous branches; red- brown fall color	prefers rich moist soil, but will grow on gravelly or rocky hillsides
<i>Cercis canadensis</i>	Redbud, Eastern	Alba	20-30	25-35	Spreading with flat top to rounded shape with reddish purple to lustrous green leaves; yellow-green fall color	Excellent ornamental, very adaptable

<i>Ginkgo biloba</i>	Ginkgo	Autumn Gold	50	30	Pyramidal shape; fan shaped leaves, bold yellow fall color	Very slow grower
<i>Gleditsia triacanthos inermis</i>	Thornless Honeylocust	Imperial	30	35	Broadly rounded; small leaflets, yellow fall color	Essentially fruitless
<i>Gleditsia triacanthos inermis</i>	Thornless Honeylocust	Shademaster, Skyline	45	35	Pyramidal with ascending branches; yellow fall color	Essentially fruitless
<i>Gymnocladus dioicus</i>	Kentucky Coffeetree	Espresso	60	40	Oval to vase shaped, yellow fall color	Espresso is fruitless cultivar, very tough in drought
<i>Liriodendron tulipifera</i>	Tuliptree		70-90	35-50	Oval to rounded shape fast growing; yellow fall color	Prefers full sun, well drained areas
<i>Malus spp.</i>	Crabapple	Royal Raindrop, Adirondack, Velvet Pillar	20	15	Upright or pyramidal; various colors of bloom and fall color	Many cultivars on the market; choose for disease resistance, bloom color and size and shape
<i>Nyssa sylvatica</i>	Black Gum (Tupelo)		45	25	Pyramidal to round; brilliant red/orange fall color	Prefers well-drained acidic soil
<i>Pistacia chinensis</i>	Chinese pistache		30	30	Rounded; leaflets with yellow fall color	Very tolerant of soils, prune young for clearance
<i>Platanus acerifolia</i>	Plane Tree, London		70-100	65-80	Large open branches with dark green leaves; yellow-brown fall color	Subject to anthracnose and cankerstain
<i>Quercus acutissima</i>	Oak, Sawtooth		50	50	Pyramidal in youth to oval rounded in maturity; lustrous leaf with golden brown fall color; fast growing in youth	Adaptable to any soil conditions

<i>Quercus muehlenbergii</i>	Oak Chinkapin		50	50	Round; leaves yellow to orange brown fall color	
<i>Quercus phellos</i>	Oak, Willow		50	35	Pyramidal in youth maturing to a dense oval; bright green foliage with russet red fall color	Can tolerate poorly drained soils
<i>Quercus robur</i>	Oak, English		55	50	Broadly round, no fall color	Acorns are long and slender; columnar cultivars are available
<i>Quercus rubra</i>	Oak, Northern Red		65	60	Rounded; fast growing; red fall color	Tolerant of pollution and compacted soil
<i>Quercus shumardii</i>	Oak, Shumard		40-60	30-40	Oval round; leaves russet red fall color	Tolerates a wide range of soil conditions, including wet soil and low spots
<i>Syringa reticulata</i>	Tree Lilac, Japanese	Ivory Silk	25	20	Rounded vase; no fall color but white flowers in late summer	Tree form lilac; can sucker at base
<i>Taxodium distichum</i>	Baldcypress	Shawnee Brave	70	25	Pyramidal spade; deciduous conifer; red/orange fall color	Adaptable to wet or dry sites
<i>Tilia americana</i>	Linden, American	American Sentry, Continental Appeal, Redmond, M Sentry, Legend	40-60	30	Symmetrically pyramidal; pale yellow fall color, fragrant flowers in spring	Prune for clearance and strong branch attachment
<i>Tilia cordata</i>	Linden, Littleleaf	Greenspire	50	40	Rounded and dense; yellow fall color with yellow fragrant flowers	Prune for clearance and strong branch attachment
