Will the city hall/police station project raise my taxes?

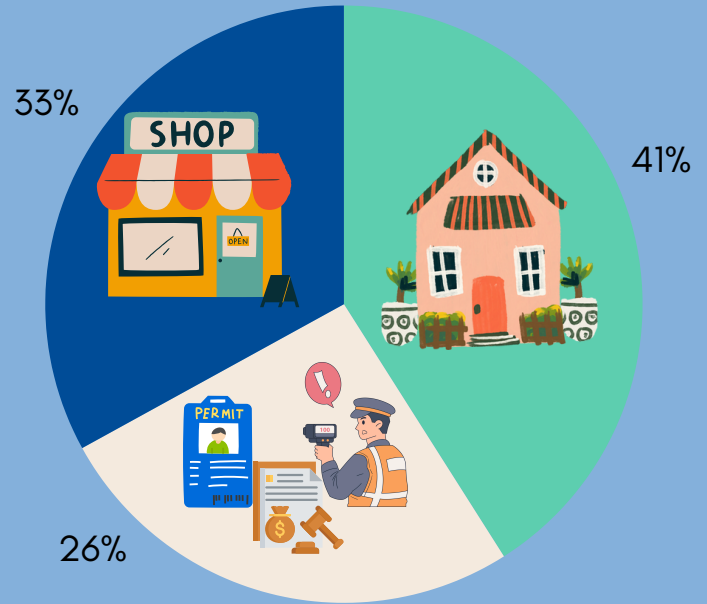

Then, how are you paying for it?

Through existing taxes and other existing revenue sources.

The project requires \$27M to be borrowed over 30 years. If that was paid entirely through property taxes, the cost to a typical* household would be around \$115/annually. However, the general fund has multiple revenue streams paid by residents and non-residents, as shown in this chart. There is no proposed increase to tax rates.

*Numbers calculated based on approximately 9,000 households and a median home value of \$435,550
