**CONCRETE SPOT REPAIRS AND FULL CURB REPLACEMENTS**

All equipment, material and workmanship must be in accordance with the Bid Documents, Plans, Project Manual and Contract Documents on file with the City Clerk, Prairie Village, Kansas. Non-resident corporations that are not already registered with the Kansas Secretary of State and all non-resident individuals and partnerships are required by law to register with the Director of Revenue, State Office Building, Topeka, Kansas, and to pay a fee of Ten Dollars (\$10.00) for each and every contract as a precedent to commencing work on the contract. For contracts in excess of Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000), the foreign contractor shall file with the Director of Revenue an acceptable bond for ten percent (10%) of the contract.
