## Mission of the Foundation

The Prairie Village Foundation is a charitable 501–(C)3 organization established to support the City of Prairie Village. Its role is to raise funds by securing and managing donations from individuals, businesses and other foundations to help support Prairie Village residents in need. We work with other organizations to provide financial and utility payment assistance, scholarships, school supplies, and other identified needs. We also foster, promote and support the arts, cultural activities, and our public parks.

## Role of Board Members

Members of the board are the key to the Foundation’s success. The first item of business each year is to elect the Board of Directors. The main role of a board member is to ensure that people are aware of the Foundation and its positive impact on our community, to help generate the financial resources needed to fulfill its mission, to organize and execute events to raise funds, and to recommend, review, and advise the Board of Directors on how best to allocate donated funds.

## Board Member Expectations

As a Board Member, I will serve a one-year term commencing on the first Tuesday in March (first Annual Meeting) and ending on the next year’s first Tuesday in March (or first Annual meeting). Additional terms will be at the discretion and invitation of the Mayor and the Foundation President.

As a Board Member, I will attend board meetings, committee meetings and foundation events.

As a Board Member, I will serve on or chair at least one event committee annually.

As a Board Member, I will review the agenda and supporting materials prior to board and committee meetings.

As a Board Member, I will be an ambassador for the Foundation. I will promote its events and communicate the good work of the foundation to the community.

As a Board Member, I will refrain from making special requests of the staff.

As a Board Member, I will strengthen the Foundation by suggesting qualified individuals for Board positions and for committee volunteers.

As a Board Member, I will support the Foundation financially by making an annual personal financial contribution at an appropriate level and will encourage others to do so as well.

**Minutes**

In attendance: Chairperson Marianne Noll, Mayor Eric Mikkelson, Board Members: Terrence Gallagher, Marti Hatridge, Bret Hanson, Cindy Jenny, Wes Jordan, Lauren Martin, Courtney McFadden, Meg Richardson, Heather Wong, Jo Yun, Staff: Meghan Boom

1. Approve Minutes from September—Courtney McFadden moved to approve the minutes. Cindy Jenny seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.
2. Recap of Fundraising for 2025—Marianne Noll reported that the general fund raised approximately \$17,000, with additional funds raised for Parks and Recreation, Shop with a Cop, and Back to School with a Firefighter. The current general fund balance is around \$46,000. Mayor Mikkelson asked for a comparison to previous years.
3. Approval of Financials—Terrence Gallagher moved to approve the minutes. Jo Yun seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.
4. Recap of Gingerbread House Party—Marti Hatridge reported that the event had more houses sold than ever before, extra trees were added as an option for sale, and the committee started marketing much earlier that led to a lot of success for the event.
5. Recap of Tree Lighting—Ms. Noll reported that the tree lighting was a great success with good community support despite very cold temperatures.
6. New fundraising ideas for 2026—Ms. Noll asked the committee to brainstorm new fundraising ideas and ways to promote the Foundation’s name in the community. Ms. McFadden suggested a Prairie Village t-shirt or merchandise to continue to raise funds for the Foundation.
7. Funding ideas for 2026—Ms. Noll highlighted new initiatives that the Foundation was able to support: grocery gift cards for families on free and reduced lunches during the government shut down/loss of SNAP benefits, as well as support to the Area Agency on Aging that provided support to Prairie Village elderly residents allowing them to remain in their homes. After sharing the Foundation’s existing areas of support, Ms. Noll asked the board to brainstorm new ways to support the community. Ms. Yun commented on the increasing expenses of childcare and wondered if there was a way to provide support for families who struggle to cover the cost. She volunteered to reach out to area providers to see if there are avenues to provide support. Ms. Richardson suggested

potential partnerships with committees, like the Diversity Committee, on some of their community outreach events.

8. 75th Anniversary events—Prairie Village is celebrating its 75<sup>th</sup> anniversary in 2026. There are a significant number of events and activities planned to celebrate the occasion, and many of the activities will benefit the Foundation, including merchandise sales, a history book, and a 5k. There will be opportunities for the Foundation to have a presence at all the events.
9. Foundation members for 2026—Ms. Noll will be contacting members about reappointments in advance of the March meeting.
